Year 3 used their sketching skills to create some lovely Cave portraits.

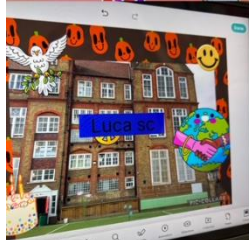
The whole school began contributing to our entry for The Big Draw competition in which the school community each contributed a doodle to a collaborative piece of art entitled 'Save Our world'.

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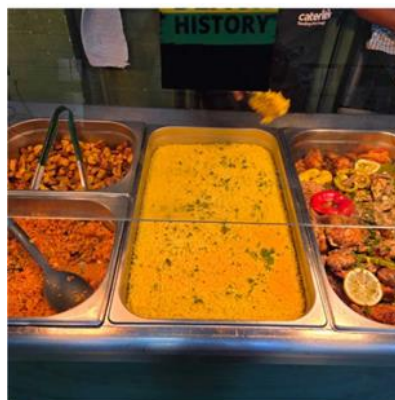
Eco Committee and Gardening Club
