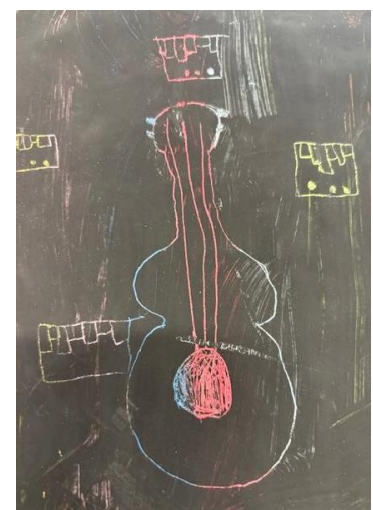
## News from the Art Room

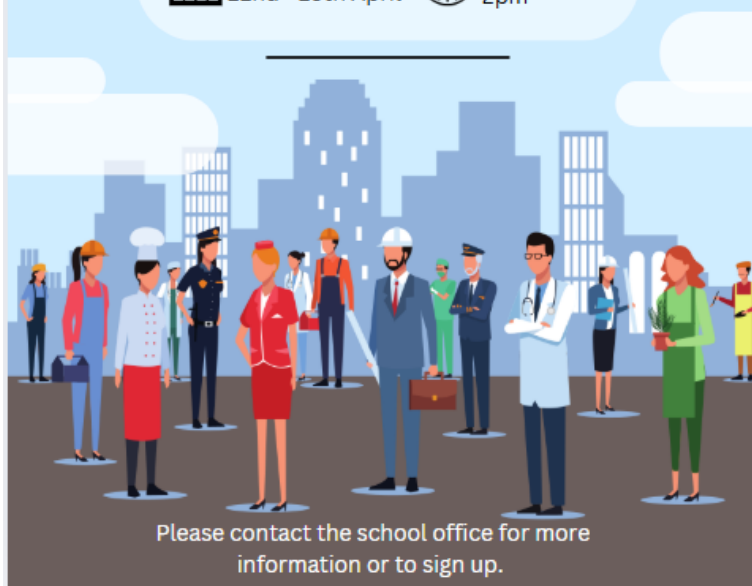
