Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to the second half of the Spring term. I hope that everyone had a lovely half term break!

We will shortly be holding our Spring Term Parents' Evening appointments. These meetings will be used to talk about the progress your child has made so far, this academic year. Teachers will also share specific targets for your child.

The appointments will be held the week beginning Monday 17th March on the following days:

Class	Parent's Evening days
Nursery	Monday 17th, Tuesday 18th and Wednesday 19th March
All other classes	Tuesday 18th and Thursday 20th March

These meetings will be held in person, at school. Appointments will continue to be 10 minutes long - it is important that this length is adhered to in order to allow the class teacher to see every parent across the two evenings. If you do feel that you need to discuss anything further with the class teacher, please get in touch with the school office who can arrange a further meeting for you. Please also remember that due to teacher workload, we are only able to offer one appointment per child.

Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your appointment time. To minimise the number of people in school, we kindly ask that you do not bring your children, if at all possible. If your child does need to accompany you to the appointment, please make sure they are supervised throughout your visit. They must not be unaccompanied around the school building. Playgrounds will be off limits as they will be in use by Magna after school club.

Appointments will be made through your Arbor account, which will be available to book from Friday 28th February at 6pm. After this time, please log in to your Arbor account and select the 'Guardian Consultation' icon from the homepage. The bookings will close on Friday 14th March at 4pm. After this time, you will need to contact the school office to book a time slot.

If you're unable to attend these meetings in person, please contact the school office who can help arrange an alternative appointment for you at a later date.

Mr Croyle, our SENCO, will be available for informal drop ins during Parents' Evening.
